

### **Easy Ice Cream Sandwiches**

#### What You Need

2 cups vanilla ice cream, slightly softened 1 cup chopped peanuts, divided 30 CHIPS AHOY! cookies

#### Make It

Mix ice cream and 1/2 cup nuts in airtight container. Freeze 20 to 30 minutes or until firm enough to hold its shape.

**Spoon** about 2 tablespoons ice cream mixture onto flat side of each of 15 cookies. Cover each with second cookie, top-side up, to make sandwich.

Roll edges in remaining nuts. Freeze 2 hours or until firm.
